1. General

The following Privacy Policy governs the online information collection practices of CREATIVE OFFICE d.o.o., a company duly established and validly existing under the laws of Croatia, having its registered seat in Zagreb, Ružmarinka 19, registered with the Court Register of the Commercial Court in Zagreb under registration number (MBS) 081019694, personal identification number (OIB) 30783111055 (hereinafter the "Company," "we" or "us"), and outlines the types of information the Company gathers about you while you are using the www.mirnabacun.com (hereinafter the "Website") and the services, features and content the Company offers (hereinafter, together with the "Website", "Services"), and the ways in which the Company uses this information.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to any information you may provide to the Company or that the Company may collect offline and/or through other means (for example, at a live event, via telephone, or through the e-mail).

Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. By using the Service, you agree that your use of Company's Services, and any dispute over privacy, is governed by this Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy and the Company's management, storing and use of information collected are governed by Croatian law.

2. Modification of the Privacy Policy

The Company reserves the right to change this Privacy Policy from time to time, in which case the Company shall post the changes to this Privacy Policy on the Website and update the date of the policy to reflect the date of the changes and may also provide notice to you through or via e-mail. In principle, new, revised and/or amended provisions of Privacy Policy shall supersede the previous provisions of earlier versions of Privacy Policy, unless otherwise expressly stated. By continuing to use the Services after the Company posts any such changes, you accept the application of Privacy Policy as revised in the latest currently available version.

3. Information the Company collects and the usage of information

The Company may collect, use and store your personal data such as your name, e-mail address and your place of residence in order to provide you with the Services. When you register on the Website, you are asked for your name and email address in order to create an account for you. Your name, e-mail address, and avatar may be used to enable you to

communicate with other users of the Services. The Company also uses your information to communicate with you about Services. The Company may also use your personal data for internal purposes such as administration of the Website, improving of the Company's services, and compliance with the Company's legal obligations.

The Company may collect and store personal or other information that you voluntarily supply to us online while using the Services. The Company only contacts individuals who specifically request so or in the event they have signed up to receive the Company's free newsletters or have purchased one of the Company's products.

The Company may collect, use and store your personal data such as name, postal address, and credit card information, which have been provided to the Company when purchasing the Company's products.

The Company uses the information it collects from you while you are using the Services in a variety of ways, including using the information to customize features.

4. Information collected by automated means

The Company collects certain information by automated means when you visit the Website. For example, the Company may collect information about your computer's connection to the Internet, which allows the Company, among other things, to improve the delivery of the Company's web pages to you and to measure traffic on the Website.

The information collected about your computer and its connection may include your non-personal information such as IP address, approximate geographic location (country, region, city), type and version of operating system and web browser used, screen and browser window dimension, cookie status, browser plugins, installed fonts etc.

The Company may also use a standard feature found in browser software called a "cookie" to enhance your experience with the Website. Cookies are bits of text that are placed on your computer's hard drive when you visit certain websites for record-keeping purposes. By showing how and when visitors use the Website, cookies help the Company deliver advertisements, identify how many unique users visit the Websites, and track user trends and patterns. They also prevent you from having to re-enter your preferences on certain areas of the Website where you may have entered preference information before. The Website may also use web beacons (single-pixel graphic files also known as "transparent GIFs") to access cookies and to count users who visit the Site or open HTML-formatted e-mail messages, Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. Google Analytics uses cookies to help analyze how users use this Website. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this Website (such as your IP address, the URL visited, the date and time the page was viewed) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google will use this information to monitor your use of this Website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and Internet usage. Google may transfer this information to third parties where required by law, or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser, however, please note that by not accepting cookies,

you may not be able to take full advantage of all features on this Website. By using this Website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner and for the purposes set out above.

5. How the Company stores your Information

Your information is stored at the HostForLife.eu. Your information can only be accessed by HostForLife.eu. The Company stores the information in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations on personal data protection.

6. How the Company protects your data

Your personal data will be collected and treated in strict confidence and kept secure according to best practices of respective industry and in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations. Access to your personal data will be restricted to a limited number of administrators. No method of transmission over the internet or electronic storage is perfectly secure. The Company shall work hard to protect your personal information, but cannot guarantee its absolute security.

7. Your control of your profile data

Once you have provided the Company with your personal data in setting up your account, you will have reasonable access to that information so you can update, modify or delete it by logging into your account.

8. Data retention

The Company retains data for purposes described in this Privacy policy for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide you services. If you no longer want us to use your information to provide you services, you may close your account. The Company will retain data to the extent necessary to comply with the Company's legal obligations, resolve disputes, operate the Company's site, and enforce its agreements. You may inform the Company of any changes or requests regarding your personal data, and the Company may in accordance with the obligations under applicable data protection law update or delete your personal information.

9. Information you make available

Please keep in mind that whenever you voluntarily make your personal information, such as your avatar, name, short bio, and username available and visible for viewing by third parties online on the Website – for example on message boards, web logs, through email, or in chat areas – that information can be seen, collected and used by others besides the Company. The Company cannot be responsible for any unauthorized third-party use of such information.

10. Information the Company shares

The Company does not sell, rent or license your personal data to third parties. However,

please be informed that the Company may also provide your information to third parties, such as service providers and contractors, for a variety of purposes, for example to enable them to provide their services to the Company or to you. Unless you inform the Company in accordance with the process described below, the Company reserves the right to use, and to disclose to third parties, all of the information collected from and about you while you are using the Services in any way and for any purpose, such as to enable the Company or a third party to provide you with information about products and services. If you do not wish your information to be used for these purposes, you shall send an e-mail with electronically confirmed receipt to: mirna@mirnabacun.com requesting to be taken off any lists of information that may be used for these purposes or that may be given or sold to third-parties.

11. Access and disclosure

The Company also reserves the right to access, read, preserve, and disclose any information as the Company reasonably believes is necessary to (i) satisfy any applicable law, regulation, legal process or governmental request, (ii) enforce the Company's Terms of use, including investigation of potential violations hereof, (iii) detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security or technical issues, (iv) respond to user support requests, or (v) protect Company's rights, property or safety, other users and the public. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for fraud protection and spam/malware prevention.

12. Transfer of assets

In some cases, the Company may choose to buy or sell various assets. In these types of transactions, user information is typically one of the transferred business assets. Moreover, if the Company, or substantially all of its assets, were acquired, or if the Company goes out of business or enter bankruptcy, user information would be one of the assets that is transferred or acquired by a third party. You acknowledge that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of the Company or the Company's assets may continue to use your Personal Information as set forth in this policy.

13. Other websites

The Website may include links to other websites and provide access to products and services offered by third parties, whose privacy policies shall not be controlled by the Company. When you access another website through the Website, use of any information you provide may be governed by the privacy policy of the operator of the website you are visiting, which the Company strongly suggests you review in case you visit any linked sites.
